



# **Memorandum of Understanding**

## **Background:**

Medication Safety is still a very important issue in LMIC's. Such is made clear by the ongoing WHO initiative: Global Patient Safety Network and their activities to improve medication management.

### Project:

By signing this MOU both SmartMed and GIMS foundation want to state their common goal towards improving medication safety:

#### SmartMed:

- is willing to provide the SmartMed Pharmacy Solution "FarmaSys" for participants in dedicated projects in LMIC's, on a non-profit base for the implementation and first 6 months period. Parties will agree a reasonable fair "market price" continuing this period which allows sustainability for either party.
- will use their influence to realize eligible discount from their suppliers for the benefit of this project.
- will not be accountable for translation matters, software adjustments, arising from local issues, structural help desk function.

#### GIMS foundation:

- will be responsible for the project fundraising.
- will do the complete project management.
- will function as a liaison between sponsors, SmartMed and local partners, healthcare authorities, academia and so forth.
- will give complete financial transparency.

• will step out a project once its predetermined goals have been realized.
